Supplies:

Watercolor paints and brushes
Watercolor paper
Construction paper or cardstock
White crayon or piece of candle wax
BAC pencil
Scissors
Glue or glue gun (use by adults)
Small piece of thick cardboard

Instructions:

Preview this video lesson first.

This is a two-step activity since drying time is required before tearing and gluing heart and wings to construction paper.

Tearing out the heart is a great activity to practice fine motor skills. Some students may require assistance or may want to practice.

This activity might make a creative handmade card for Mother's Day!!
