Supplies:

Art paper BAC pencil Pastels in box – these are oil pastels – they can be broken into pieces to have enough for your students Colored pencils in your box to supplement school supplies Silk flower – you may want to add more flowers or photos (sample below) Heart shape cut outs in box if you want to use to make hearts to glue onto artwork Protective cover for workspace Paint smock to protect clothes from pastels Wet paper towels or wipes for hands Hair spray or spray fixative (teachers apply)
