

Advanced Watercolor Collage

Supplies:

Watercolor paints and brushes

Watercolor paper

Old magazines

Scissors

Natural materials - plan a walk outside for students to gather some materials

Glue or glue gun for adult use

Protective cover for table

Smock, large shirt to protect clothing

Instructions:

Begin by watching the entire video.

You may want to refer to the Watercolor Techniques video for painting options for background. If you choose to use this activity you may want to consider doing it in two parts so that the step one will have time to dry before gluing on items to watercolor page.

When the piece is completed and dried you can glue it to a larger piece of construction paper or cardstock to add support and a more finished look.
