Application & Acceptance

Is this training program right for me?

This six-month program is designed for veterans and adults with disabilities over age 18 who have an interest in a career in the IT industry. Potential candidates should have basic computer experience, and the problem-solving capacity to develop skills, knowledge, and workplace readiness. All candidates must self-identify as a person with a disability and are expected to pass a competency assessment to determine their ability to work at the required levels of proficiency in math, communication, and social skills to be successful within the context of the program.

How do I apply for this program?

LaunchIT Adult Program is an approved Miscellaneous Training program for Florida Vocational Rehabilitation and Connecticut Bureau of Rehabilitation Services. Discuss this training opportunity with your Counselor TODAY! Once we receive a referral from your counselor, a BAC staff member will contact you regarding completing the application and assessment online.

How do I know if my application was received?

When will I know if I've been accepted?

Acceptance to the LaunchIT Adult Program is on a rolling basis. Acceptance decisions are made after you've successfully passed the assessment and completed a virtual interview with a member of the Codecraft Works staff.

Is this a virtual training program?

All LaunchIT training will be conducted via virtual platforms that are accessible to those with unique abilities. This program is available virtually nationwide.

Can I apply for this program from my smartphone?

No. The testing and application process must be completed on a desktop or computer.

What are the minimum technology requirements to participate in this program?

Participants are required to have a reliable high-speed internet connection, computer or laptop with modern browser, headphones or speakers, microphone, and a web camera.
