20-HOUR (1-WEEK) VIRTUAL CYBER-SAFETY CAREER CAMP

Presented by BAC and Codecraft Works

Monday-Friday, March 17th – 21st, 2025 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm

Students who complete both 10 hours Work Readiness and 10 hours of Job Exploration training will receive a \$150 stipend.

Career Camp is open to Florida students ages 14-21, in school with an IEP or 504 Plan. Disclaimer: Any student who receives incentives, gifts, etc. from BAC may receive a tax form reporting the receipt of payments. For questions, please consider consulting a financial advisor.

The program includes work readiness lessons, certifications, and career presenters. Sessions will be live and interactive, while including discussions about cyber-safety, career navigation, and community impact. Lessons will be adjusted for students who may need accommodation.

Students **MUST be referred** to the program by Vocational Rehabilitation. If interested, please contact your VR Counselor or local VR office for a referral.
